

One-Hour 50 gram Glucose Tolerance

Instruction Notes:

- Follow any special instructions your practitioner may have given.
- The glucose beverage is available through the laboratory and tastes best if refrigerated prior to ingesting.
- The glucose drink must be ingested within 5 minutes.
- Once the glucose drink has been ingested, you must not have anything to eat or drink and not smoke until after the blood specimen is drawn.

Patient Instruction:

- 1. If your provider requires fasting, have nothing by mouth except for water 12 hours prior to test. Water is encouraged to avoid dehydration.
- 2. On the day of the test you will need the 50 gm glucose beverage provided by the laboratory.
- 3. At the desired time, drink the glucose beverage within 5 minutes.
- 4. Note the time you finished drinking the beverage.
- 5. Plan to <u>arrive at the laboratory 30 minutes</u> after the finish time. Your blood must be drawn exactly 1 hour after the finish time to ensure an accurate test result.
- 6. Register at the FMH Admissions desk located on the first floor of the main clinic building.
- 7. After registration, bring paperwork to the laboratory reception area and tell the personnel what time you finished drinking the glucose beverage.
- 8. Your blood will be drawn exactly one hour after that time.

Timing example:

9:00	Start drinking the glucose beverage.
9:05	Finish drinking the beverage and note time.
9:35	Arrive at the clinic and register at the Fairbanks Memorial Admissions desk located in the first floor lobby.
10:05	Blood draw is performed.
